

## Steps for Proposed Projects Submittal

- The attached (Project Idea Form) to be filled out and sent under a cover letter addressed to the General Director of the Public Authority for Housing Welfare accompanied with a preliminary feasibility study for the project.
- PAHW will then study the project and notify the idea owner of its acceptance or rejection. PAHW will also classify the idea as an initiative or distinguished project in case of acceptance.
- If the project is accepted, the owner of (the initiative / distinguished project) will submit a detailed feasibility study within six months subject to a further extension according to the nature of the project.
- PAHW will then review the detailed feasibility study and if approved, PAHW will tender the project in accordance to PAHW's investment resolution and applicable laws and provisions.
- The owner of (the initiative / distinguished project) may compete during the tendering stage with the other companies eligible to participate.
- The owner of (the initiative / distinguished project) will have the rights established in this regard.
- The successful company will be engaged under a contract to develop the project.
